Grass cutting – members will agree the new grass cutting contractor for next year at the January meeting. Members were sad to hear of the untimely death of Barry Colville who has been the contractor for the parish council for several years.

Trees – the trees on the village green will be surveyed in December. Any work required will be agreed at the next meeting in January.

Play Area – The annual play area inspection was undertaken in October. Councillors Brocklebank and Hogg are reviewing the work required which is minor repairs to seating, some equipment and safety surfacing.
